


## I.The french national export control authority at a glance

- « Service des biens à double usage » (SBDU):
- Entity created in 2010 by gathering 4 ministerial units formerly involved in dual use export control process.
- Linked to the ministry of economy, which is the legal authority for organisation and decisions; SBDU is a national department, close to but not like an agency.
- Staff = 17 (half civil officers, half technical experts)
- licencing activity: ~ 5000/year, ~ 3% denials
- Average time to grant a licence: 30 days.
- SBDU cost /licence : 330€ (~ X2 for full public costs)



#### PROCESS DIAGRAM FOR DUAL-USE EXPORT AUTHORISATION APPLICATIONS - FRANCE





## Il dealing with perspectives of regulatory changes; the 428 recast

### Member state typical concern about :

- new definition of « dual use » (risk of dilution), specific list (cyber)
- Double access to catch non listed goods (risk of extension of administrative burden)

#### Control authority office typical interest to :

- Clarification of definitions (exporter, technical assistance, ICP ....)
- New EUGEA's (simplification/tranfert of burden)
- Catch all coordination among MS, wich remain free to decide

#### .....In a wider environment

- Recast process has to be linked to non EU regulation initiatives,
- European and CR outreach action plans may help to record capacity building by third countries
- Control regimes system goes on (must prevail technically)
