

- Sometimes with consultation from a pool of registered experts
- All steps from application to issuance are processed via YESTRADE

Support CP and SMB



Support for Compliance Program

- Offering advice for applicants to help be certified as A, AA and AAA
- After certified, Keep supporting to maintain compliance system

Support for SMB(Home Doctor Consulting)

- 200-300 companies a year apply and receive this service
- Offering consulting to help comply with export control system
- Opening an online management system in 2013



Online System(Yestrade)

Main Functions

- Portal Service : General Information
- Classification Service : 100% online service
- Licensing : 100% online
- Reporting : Transaction Report (CP certified companies, License exempted transaction)
- Data Links : with Customs, Ministry of Unification, Defense Acquisition and Procurement Agency
